RE: Weekly COVID-19 Update

Good morning! The Southeast District Health Department has updated the information on their website. There is a total of 16 new cases and one death in the district in the last week. None of the new cases were in Johnson County, three were in Nemaha County, 11 were in Otoe County, none were in Pawnee County and two were in Richardson County. This makes a total of 3,916 cases and 62 deaths in the district. 97 of the cases were diagnosed in the last 30 days.

There have been some people interested in knowing the number vaccinations that have been given by our hospital. So far, we have administered 3,523 doses of vaccine. We gave 147 doses last week. We are having a difficult time finding people willing to receive all of the vaccine that we have been allocated. We even started offering the vaccine to walk-ins last week. We also were able to get some Pfizer vaccine to give to those 16 and older last week. Please share the importance of becoming vaccinated with your friends and family.

As of 9:00 this morning there were 158,400,711 cases in the world. Last Monday there were 152,946,524. There have been 3,294,657 deaths. Last Monday there had been 3,204,301 deaths.

In the United States there are now 32,708,028 positive cases and 581,755 deaths. Last Monday there were 32,422,234 cases and 577,046 deaths. There were 285,794 new cases diagnosed last week and 4,709 deaths.

In Nebraska there are now 221,434 cases and there have been 2,251 deaths. Last Monday there had been 220,127 positive cases and 2,245 deaths. 1,307 new confirmed cases have been identified in the last week and 509 of those cases were in Douglas County. We now have had 786 confirmed cases in Nemaha County, 236 in Pawnee County, 781 in Richardson County, 653 in Johnson County and 1,460 in Otoe County. These are the numbers of cases in each county as reported by the Southeast District Health Department. 71,222 of the Nebraska cases are in Douglas County. There have now been 7,778 confirmed cases in Hall County, 2,883 cases in Dawson County and 3,924 cases in Dakota County. There are now 2,185 cases in Gage County and 31,284 cases in Lancaster County.
